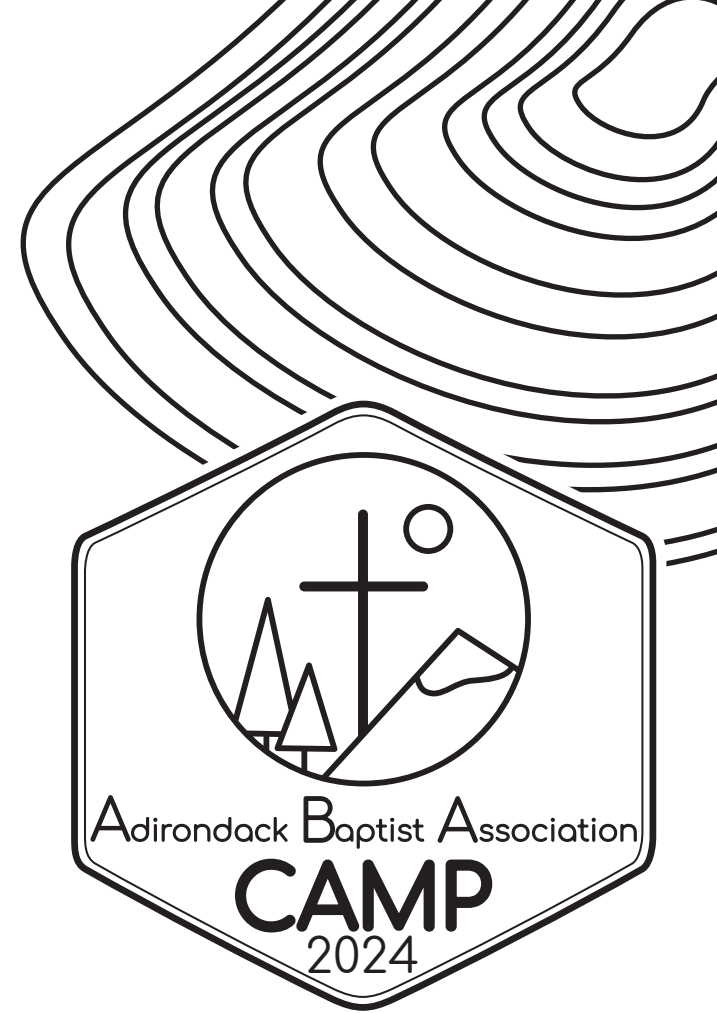
Check-out: 10am-12pm

DIRECTIONS from Malone:

- in Malone, take State Route 30 South
- Go less than a mile to the top of the hill and turn left in front of the bowling alley
- Go straight 2 blocks
- Take a right
- Duane St (towards Chasm Falls)
- At Chasm Falls the road forks, bear to the left at the fork (toward's Owls Head)
- Just past the Catholic Church there will be a road to the right that takes you to Mountain View, Go 3 miles
- You will see a large sign that says -"Welcome to Mountain View" and the road will fork
- Stay to the left at the fork. There will be a 4-H Camp Overlook sign
- Go a couple hundred yards and take your first left
- This road will lead straight into Camp Overlook

DIRECTIONS from the Tri Lakes:

- On State Route 30, turn right onto County Route 99
- Follow this road (do no turn right when Route 99 turns, but go straight)
- Mt View is about 10 miles from Route 30.
- Go straight into Mt View, Turn right after the one-lane bridge.
- 4H Camp Overlook will be straight ahead.

RULES

- Campers must attend and participate in all scheduled camp activities.
- Campers may leave camp only with the approval of the Camp Director.
- Kind, considerate, and good, moral behavior is expected at all times.
- All un-permitted items (what to leave at home), if brought to camp, will be held by the director until campers are dismissed on Saturday morning.
- Any camper refusing to obey camp rules or cooperate with camp staff will be asked to leave camp. Forfeiture of camp fee will result.

COST:

\$160 per camper and \$145 for each additional sibling

- Counselor/Staff \$75 (Ins. Cost)
- Make checks payable to: Adirondack Baptist Association Camp
- All camper registrations must be received by August 7th
- Counselor forms must be received by August 7th

WHAT NOT TO BRING?

- All electronic equipment (CD, laptops, ipods, cell phone)
- *hair dryers, curling irons, clocks and razors are allowed
- Tobacco, vapes, alcohol, illegal drugs, weapons, food, candy
- Inappropriate clothing,
 - short shorts (must be mid thigh when sitting)
 - short skirts (must be near knees)
 - any shirts with pictures or slogans that are inappropriate
 - clothing that reveals too much skin or underclothing, no belly shirts, spaghetti straps tanks

*Camp Staff has the right to search campers belongings as needed.

WHAT TO BRING?

- Bible
- Notebook
- Bedding
- Extra Blanket
- Flashlight
- 2 Towels
- Washcloths
- Pen/Pencil
- Toiletries (Toothbrush, toothpaste, soap, shampoo, deodorant, brush, comb, floss)
- Casual Dress Clothes (Pants, shorts, extras)
- *Camp clothes get dirty. Don't pack anything that you would be upset about if it's ruined.
- Informal Dress Clothes, for evening meals and worship services (no shorts in evening)
- Swimsuit, dark t-shirt (for water activities) and beach towel
- Shoes (Bring sneakers for recreation, and an extra pair)
- Jacket
- Canteen Money (Campers have the option to bring extra money to purchase snacks between meals. Money will be collected at check in and any leftover returned at the end of the week. Campers shouldn't have cash in the cabin.)
